

July 26, 2010 Special Council Meeting

The Ashby City Council held a Special Council Meeting on July 26, 2010 at Ashby City Hall. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss switching health insurance from Lakes Country Service Coop to AT Group. Mayor Thomas Grover called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with council members George Jordan, Ronnie Jaenisch and Lynn Jensen present. Absent was Carl Ulrich. Also present was Val Martin – Clerk/Treasurer, Thor Tollefson, Chief of Police/Public Works and Dan Reynoso from AT Group.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Dan Reynoso presented a plan for health insurance from Medica. The plan will change from the \$300 deductible to \$1700/\$3400 deductible and will include a City contribution to a Health Savings Plan which will be \$1400 for single and \$2500 for family. This plan will save the City a minimum of \$1433.40 per year. This does not take into consideration any increases that would happen on January 1, 2010 with Lakes Country Service Coop. It will become effective on 9/1/2010 and the rate will be good for one year. Jaenisch moved to switch from Lakes Country Service Coop to AT Group effective 9/1/2010. Jensen seconded. MCU. Note that the decision to discontinue health insurance with Lake Country needed to be done prior to July 31, 2010.

Jaenisch moved to adjourn. Jensen seconded. MCU
