**Regular Meeting**  
**October 10, 2019**

- Regular Meeting** A regular council meeting of the City of Ashby, MN was held at Ashby City Hall with the following members present: Tom Grover, Heather Rossum, Wayne Stierlen, Carrie Jante and Jeremy Obright Absent: None. Also present: Clerk Schmitz, Superintendent Johnson and Deputy Clerk Helle. Absent: None. Visitor's Present: Winnie & Alden Thompson. Mayor Grover called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.
- Approval** Upon motion from Stierlen, seconded by Rossum, and unanimously carried, the agenda was approved as presented.
- Visitors:** There were no visitor's present.
- Minutes/Claims/Consent Agenda** Upon motion from Jeremy Obright, seconded by Rossum, and unanimously carried, council approved the consent agenda which includes minutes of the regular council meeting of September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019, the Special Workshop Meeting of October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 and the claims and prepaid disbursements of October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019 as presented and reviewed by Council Member Carrie Obright.
- Mayor Report** Representatives from Soil & Water Conservation & Lake Shore Management visited with the Mayor regarding water quality in Ashby and the surrounding area.

- Public Safety - Law Enforcement Report** Council reviewed the September 2019 log report as presented by the Sheriff's Department.
- Fire/Ambulance Department** The Fire/Ambulance report was reviewed.

- Public Works** Superintendent Johnson reported that the shelter and bathrooms in the park have been closed. The CSAH 82 project roadwork is complete. The Fiber Optic line project is almost complete. After the recent pond discharge, results showed limits were drastically reduced from this time last year due to the pre-treatment of the large commercial user.
