Council discussed options for large/heavy amounts of solid waste produced by large commercial users and appropriate disposal methods moving forward. The council also discussed the concern about the safety hazards regarding the current process with heavy compacted bailing in dumpsters of an inadequate size for the amount of weight. The Garbage Ordinance will be updated once all processes have been approved and put in place. Standish and Attorney Anderson will present options to the Grant County Commissioners before final decisions are made by the City Council. Council instructed the producer to increase the number of dumpsters currently in use based on the amount of Solid Waste produced until a different process has been determined.
