**Emergency Meeting**

An Emergency council meeting of the City of Ashby, MN was held at Ashby City Hall with the following members present: Tom Grover, Ronnie Jaenisch, Wayne Stierlen, Carrie Obright and Jeremy Obright Absent: None. Also present: Clerk Schmitz and Superintendent Johnson. Absent: None. Visitor's Present: Kristi Froemming – TFC Poultry. Mayor Grover called the meeting to order at 11:30 am.

The Ashby City Council met to discuss the damages and mitigation efforts needed as a result of the storm that went through Ashby on May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Council addressed what efforts need to be made regarding street sweeping and clean up needed. Kristi Froemming was present to offer that TFC Poultry will go around and pick up any trees and brush that are left on the curb as well as go into the brush site and remove all brush deposited there. Froemming will draft a message and Clerk Schmitz will post the detail on the City Facebook page.

Superintendent Johnson reported that the street sweepers will be able to come back and sweep streets in about a week.

The city received a request for information from Grant County Emergency Management regarding city damages from the storm. Mayor Grover and Clerk Schmitz drove around town to assess damage to City Infrastructure as well as any private residential/business damages. There was no city infrastructure damage. There was significant tree damage on private properties and some damages to private structures. There were 1-2 street lights that came down.

There was discussion regarding the tornado siren. Due to the power outage there was no way to activate the tornado siren when the storm was approaching. This was the same issue in other cities in Grant County.
